In order to graduate from the Honors College, Honors students must, among other requirements*, complete a minimum of nine hours of Honors coursework, three hours of which must be interdisciplinary. While it is preferred that all nine hours of Honors coursework be completed at the College of Charleston, the Dean of the Honors College may grant permission for a course taken while studying away to count as either an Honors interdisciplinary or non- interdisciplinary class, depending on the nature of the course.

*Other Honors College requirements are Honors English, Honors Western Civ, Calculus, a 200-level Math class, a 3 credit hour Independent Study and a 6 credit hour Bachelor's Essay. Some of these requirements may be satisfied with AP credits.
